Every year, Full Life Care's dedicated staff provides an array of essential services, and our volunteers reaffirm our commitment to keeping people as healthy as possible and living in the community.

It takes a highly-trained team to provide care to frail elders, and people with memory loss, developmental disabilities, acquired brain injury, multiple sclerosis, mental illness and many other chronic conditions. Nurses and occupational therapists provide skilled interventions in our adult day health centers, dementia care specialists work with the residents in our memory care homes, and psychiatric ARNPs and mental health clinicians enable us to provide community-based behavioral health services. Scores of case managers, assistants and aides are integral to our programs.

And so are our volunteers. Full Life and its programs benefit from the gifts of time and expertise of myriad volunteers, from our dedicated board members to individuals who visit our sites and share their talents with our clients. A special group of volunteers are our full-time volunteers.

In 2012, Full Life was fortunate to receive invaluable support from members of the Lutheran Volunteer Corps and Jesuit Volunteer Corps. We reached a milestone in developing volunteerism in our agency when Washington Service Corps awarded Full Life 10 AmeriCorps positions through its Healthy Futures Special Initiative.

Healthy living, smoking cessation, alleviation of depression and community engagement are themes that figure prominently in their work with Full Life participants.

BY THE NUMBERS

ADULT DAY HEALTH

49,953 days of service provided at centers in King and Snohomish counties.

CARE CONSULTATION

Care Consultation provided to 58 families, helping them plan care for older adults and persons with Alzheimer's disease or multiple sclerosis.

HOME CARE

210,000 in-home hours were provided to 325 clients.

SOLSTICE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

Solstice provided mental health services to 325 clients, including Seattle Housing Authority residents who are at risk of losing their housing.

VOLUNTEERS

675 volunteers, including 10 full-time service members, gave 36,035 hours of service. Their contribution is valued at \$794,690 in support of Full Life Care.

IN CELEBRATION OF OUR 2012-2013 FULL-TIME VOLUNTEERS

I began a weekly healthy lifestyle group for women with development disabilities. I brought in two nursing students and we worked with the clients to develop weekly goals related to healthy eating habits and exercise. Now, the clients are more motivated to make healthy eating choices and to exercise on a more regular basis. For example, one client who has quite a sweet tooth decided on her own to only have one piece of pie on Thanksgiving and save the second (or third) piece to have on separate days. After spending time with our clients, I realize I want to continue working with persons with disabilities. And helping them one-on-one has me excited about pursuing further schooling and a career in occupational therapy.

Some residents at Gaffney House and Buchanan Place cannot participate in structured art activities or even have a conversation. In seeking to enrich their lives, I felt as though I had struck gold when I discovered the power that babies can have in the lives of persons living with dementia. Seattle Housing Authority implemented a no smoking policy that improved the health and wellness of its non-smoking residents, but it proved challenging for people who continue to smoke. I and a Full Life Care service coordinator, along with Seattle & King County Public Health, arranged meetings in several SHA buildings to discuss smoking cessation resources. Residents (who were often also friends and family members) helped smokers who were at risk of losing their housing because of the new policy. They discussed the challenges of quitting smoking and provided essential peer support. We also explored other elements of a healthy lifestyle, such as getting enough sleep and exercise, and eating fruits and vegetables.




